These series of 5 workshops are aimed at Headteachers & Reading/Phonic Leads who wish to improve outcomes in early reading and phonics. It is recommended that participants attend all 6 sessions and complete the gap tasks in between each one. For example, if provision in phonics is already strong, but the Reading Lead is new to the role, then Workshop 4 would be appropriate.
