Cost →

Full scholarship funding, with no cost to the participant, for the NPQ for Early Headship Coaching Offer is available for those who meet the following criteria:

- Have either completed an NPQH before taking up your first headship post or are currently taking one.
- Are employed in a state-funded school, or are employed in a state-funded 16 to 19 organisation in England or starting the training.
